Petition of Pegasus Residents Group Incorporated: Ensure that the Pegasus Golf Course development proposal is not fast-tracked

The Petitions Committee has considered the petition of Pegasus Residents Group Incorporated, which was presented to the House on 24 July 2026 by Dan Rosewarne. The petition was signed by 15,811 people, and requests:

That the House of Representatives urge the Government to ensure that the proposal to redevelop the Pegasus Golf Course is not progressed through the fast-track approvals process, and instead proceeds through standard public planning and Resource Management Act processes.

The application to refer the project to the fast-track approvals process was declined by the Minister for Infrastructure on 19 August 2026.¹

We received a submission from the petitioner welcoming the decision. The petitioner asked us to recommend stronger guidelines or amendments to the Fast-track Approvals Act 2024 regarding the eligibility of housing developments for fast-track consideration. We think this goes well beyond the original petition request. The petitioner may wish to start a new petition about the broader points it wishes to make about housing developments.

We have no further matters to bring to the attention of the House. We recommend that the House take note of our report.
