Petition of Brian Webb: Prevent Trump and associates with convictions from entering or investing in NZ

The Petitions Committee has considered the petition of Brian Webb, which was presented to the House on 22 October 2025 by Shanan Halbert. The petition was signed by 77 people, and requests:

That the House of Representatives pass legislation that prevents Donald J Trump and his associates and family who have been convicted in America or elsewhere as criminals or felons from entering or investing in the realm of New Zealand.

We think that current immigration settings are sufficient to deal with the petitioner's request. We have no further matters to bring to the attention of the House. We recommend that the House take note of our report.
