Petition of Brian Webb: Vote of no confidence in the coalition Government

The Petitions Committee has considered the petition of Brian Webb, presented on 29 January 2025, requesting:

That the House of Representatives express no confidence in the Government and its actions.

The petitioner made a short submission expressing his concerns about the policies and decisions of the coalition Government. He asked that the House move no confidence in the Government.

We do not believe this is appropriate business for our committee. Given the mechanisms that currently exist for no confidence motions, which can be instigated by any member at any time, we do not believe that this petition requires the intervention of the Petitions Committee.

We have no further matters to bring to the attention of the House. We recommend that the House take note of our report.
